Chromebook Repair Drop-Off During Distance Learning Weeks

During the distance learning weeks, Chromebook repair drop-off will be available Monday through Thursday at **Elkhorn High School**. Chromebook repair drop-off is **by appointment only**.

To get the repair process started parents/guardians/students will go to: <https://forms.elkhornweb.org/help> and sign into the form with the student's epsne.org Google credentials. Parents/Guardians/Students please be as detailed as possible when submitting this form. Upon submission, this will create a ticket in our Help Desk system. All further Help Desk ticket communication will be done via the parent's/guardian's and student's email address (if applicable). Appointments will be made and communicated via the Help Desk ticket/email.

Winter Break



School will be dismissed for the Winter Break at 3:06 p.m. on Friday, December 18. There is a Teacher In-Service Day on Monday, December 21st and Tuesday, December 22nd. Classes will resume with a week of distance learning starting on Monday, January 4, 2020.

Recess

Just a reminder that students will be going outside each day for recess, weather permitting. Please make sure that your child dresses appropriately so that he or she can enjoy their time outdoors.

Please remember that school doors do not open until 7:55 AM. Please do not drop off your children before 7:55 AM. There is no supervision until 7:55 AM.

Safety Patrol

Safety patrol students will be at their posts throughout the winter months except during extreme weather. We always appreciate their leadership and assistance but especially during this time of year. Please thank these school

Requirements for Screening, Exclusion, and Re-Admittance of Ill Students and Staff in Schools

REQUIRED under the State's current DHM

Students and staff with any one (1) of the following symptoms: new cough, new onset of shortness of breath, or new loss of taste or smell.

Students and staff with two (2) or more of the following: fever 100.4 F. or above, chills, muscle aches, headache, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue.

Students and staff immediately isolate in the designated area and sent home as soon as possible.

Require the symptomatic person to wear a cloth or surgical mask over nose and mouth while waiting, if tolerable.

Criteria for Re-Admittance to School

Symptomatic staff /student who tests positive:

Exclude until:

- At least 10* days have passed since first symptoms

AND

- At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications

AND

- Symptoms have improved

Asymptomatic staff /student who tests positive:

Exclude until:

- At least 10 days have passed since the positive test

AND

- only allow to return if no symptoms develop. (If symptoms develop, refer to symptomatic positive instructions.)

Symptomatic staff /student not tested:

Exclude until:

- At least 10* days have passed since first symptoms

AND

- At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications

AND

- Symptoms have improved

May return to school if a doctor establishes an alternative diagnosis, provides a return to school note, and the student meets the school's requirements for readmission.

*This length of time may need to be extended for people who have severe illness or are immunocompromised. Please consult your LHD or a health care provider for further guidance on those situations.

Symptomatic staff /student who tests negative:

Exclude until:

- At least 24 hours have passed since last fever without the use of fever-reducing medications (or meets the school's requirements for readmission)

AND

- Symptoms have improved

AND

- Student has completed quarantine, if required due to an exposure to a positive COVID-19 case

Note: A COVID-19 positive individual does not need a repeat COVID-19 test or a doctor's note in order to return.
